5TH AND 6TH GRADE READING CHALLENGE

This year we'll nurture our love of reading in fifth and sixth grades by sharing in a new quarterly reading challenge. This challenge is a way to encourage students to further explore WCA's library collection (and other books as well), and to find books that interest and challenge their intellect and imagination.

Because fifth and sixth grade students are in different places on their reading journey, there will be several different ways for students to complete the challenge. Students may choose the option that best suits their reading level and style. They may choose the same option each quarter or try a different one.

This challenge is **OPTIONAL** and is simply meant as a fun way to encourage students in their reading life. **ALL** kinds of reading will count! Does your family read aloud together? That counts! Do you read your Bible? You may count one book of the Bible toward your reading goal each quarter! We'll be sharing our progress and book recommendations along the way in library class. Incentives may be offered for completion at the end of each quarter, but again, participation is not required. This is a way for students to set a personal goal for their reading lives and strive to meet it. If you fall short of your goal? No worries - you read more than you would have read otherwise. Hooray for you!

The options for the reading challenge are as follows:

Option 1: Read ANY seven books of your choice in a quarterly grading period. These must be grade level books approved by the librarian or parent. (Books longer than 300 pages will count as 2 books!)

Option 2: Select and read any five books from the reading challenge list provided. (See reverse side.)

Option 3: Read any five books of your choice and complete a peer book recommendation for each, to be placed on our book recommendation bulletin board located in the library.

Option 4: Read 750 pages of grade level reading material.
